IMPROVEMENT WORK – Calder Valley Track renewals

I am writing to inform you that Network Rail needs to undertake essential work as part of the Calder Valley Railway Upgrade programme. This programme will deliver faster services between key towns and cities across the North.

This work is to renew life-expired rail along with routine track maintenance work in the Hebden Bridge to Milner Royd area. In order to carry out this work we will be using Track Machines, Hand Tools such as disc cutters, grinders etc. along with generators for lightning, Trains and other plant.
