LOCKDOWN (No 3) REGULATIONS

The Prime Minister asked people to stay at home from (04 Jan 2021), with a legal requirement to do so being introduced in regulations in the coming days (Wednesday 06 Jan 2021). The lockdown will run until the middle of February. Scientists concluded that the new variant was 50-70% more transmissible. The NHS expects to have offered the vaccination to everyone in the priority groups of elderly, clinically extremely vulnerable and frontline health and social care workers by mid-February. The key advice for anybody in the top group for vaccination; elderly, clinically extremely vulnerable is STAY AT HOME until you get the jab and then allow three weeks for immunity.

Reasons to leave home

You are allowed to leave home for a limited number of reasons. Holy Mass is one of them.

Holy Mass - You can leave home to attend or visit a place of worship for communal worship, a funeral or event related to a death, a burial ground or a remembrance garden.

You should follow the guidance on the safe use of places of worship and must not mingle with anyone outside of your household or support bubble when attending a place of worship. Remember, if your health is not good and you are vulnerable, if you have a cough or cold or temperature you should stay at home. For more information visit www.gov.uk/coronavirus
