ATTENDING CHURCH FOR HOLY MASS

You can leave home to attend or visit a place of worship for communal worship, a funeral or event related to a death, a cemetery or a remembrance garden. You should follow the guidance at all times - you must not mingle with anyone outside of your household or support bubble when attending a place of worship, remember, if your health is not good and you are vulnerable, if you have a cough or cold or temperature you should stay at home.

Our Parish has reviewed our risk, especially all factors that could affect good COVID security

- 1. Sufficient stewarding and management of the venue
- 2. Sufficient cleaning after acts of communal worship
- 3. Maintaining good social distancing in the space available along with good ventilation and the compulsory wearing of face coverings
- 4. The length of exposure time for an act of worship is critical and should be minimised
- 5. Mass should be celebrated reverently but in the briefest period of time possible
- 6. Ensure booking systems are in place and effective.
- 7. Ensure that contact details of all present are recorded for 21 days.
- 8. Where feasible have an NHS Test and Trace QR Code for each church
- 9. Those who have gathered for Mass should not mingle before or after the service outside of the church.
- 10. If for any reason the above measures cannot be adequately achieved, we would have to temporarily close the church
- 11. Remember, if your health is not good and you are vulnerable, if you have a cough or cold or temperature you should stay at home.
