SYNODAL PROCESS As you will be aware, following the completion of the listening exercise that was carried out as part of the Synod 2021 – 2023, we are now continuing with the second phase of our ongoing diocesan listening process. This will focus on identifying the pastoral priorities for the diocese as we move forward from the pandemic. Many of the volunteer facilitators have agreed to revisit the parishes they went to in the first phase. They have been asked to contact Parish Priests in order to identify a mutually convenient date, time and venue for a parish meeting. Again, there will also be the opportunity for individuals and groups to complete online questionnaires or to make written submissions. In this second phase, people will be asked to consider three questions:

The parish is the presence of the Church in a given territory, an environment for hearing God's word, for growth in the Christian life, for dialogue, proclamation, charitable outreach, worship and celebration. In all its activities the parish encourages and trains its members to be evangelizers. (Evangelii Gaudium 28)

1. What, within our current practice as a parish and diocese, helps to fulfil this vision?
2. What would our parish and diocese look like if this vision was being fully lived?
3. What practical steps can we take to move towards that fully lived reality?
