A summary of our financial position and transactions for the year April 2021-March 2022 has been sent as a separate attachment last week.

More recently, from 01 April up to and including 19 June the parish has received: Loose cash £192.71
Envelopes £271.00
2nd collection envelopes £40
Coffee money £123.97
Votive Candles £71.03
Web giving £58.48

The bulk of our income comes from regular standing orders. These come at various frequencies, from weekly to annual, but average at about £2,075 per month. Many thanks for all your donations.

Parish Tithe

You will see from the annual summary that we have been catching up with paying out the tithe. Whilst we would hope to maintain our relationship with, and support of, the existing recipients of the tithe we are also happy to consider any other charities you wish to nominate. These would then be considered by the Finance Committee and the Consultors and can be discussed at the AGM in the autumn.

The recipients last year were Overgate Hospice and 4 charities supporting refugees and asylum seekers either through housing or legal support and advice (Beacon, Manuel Bravo, Abigail Housing, St Monica's Housing).
