INQUIRY INTO ASSISTED SUICIDE From the Anscombe Bioethics Centre: “The House of Commons Health and Social Care Committee has launched an Inquiry into assisted suicide, and is inviting comments from individual members of the public and interested organisations to comment. Assisted suicide presents profound dangers to public safety and the common good, and so it is crucial that as many people as possible engage with the Parliamentary Inquiry and oppose the introduction of assisted suicide into UK law. Submissions must be in by Friday 20 January 2023. The Anscombe Bioethics Centre has produced a short two-page Briefing (also attached) to help anyone interested in responding, whether as an individual or as an organisation.
