LENT HOUSE GROUPS Churches Together have organised a course for the Lent house groups. They will start the week beginning 26 February. They would like to invite you to engage more fully with Lent this year through poetry. Ecumenical groups will be meeting weekly at different locations, days and times across Hebden Royd once a week for the 5 full weeks of Lent before Holy Week. One group will also meet on Zoom.

The course will be rooted in the poems set out, in Janet Morley's book, 'the heart's time'. This is an existing favourite of some and an excellent introduction to reflection and poetry for anyone open to it: those anxious about poetry and those who already love it; those articulate about their faith and spirituality and those full of questions and uncertainty ... and all in between. Groups aim to be hospitable where all opinions and questions are valued; where you can actively contribute or just listen if you prefer. Each week a related Bible passage will be suggested, along with 2 of the poems Janet Morley has selected on the week's theme. If you want to buy your own copy of the book, you could engage even more fully with Lent by reading a poem each day when you were able. It is available on line (including second-hand e.g., from World of Books) or Bookcase on Market Street, Hebden Bridge will order a copy for you, at £10.99. If you can't make it to any of the groups - or don't fancy a group - you might like to use the book this Lent anyway. Please sign the list at the back of church or let Kay know if you wish to take part.

A NEW AUXILIARY BISHOP FOR THE ARCHDIOCESE OF SOUTHWARK His Holiness Pope Francis has appointed **Mgr. Philip Moger** as an Auxiliary Bishop for Southwark. Born in 1955, Bishop-Elect Philip Moger grew up in Halifax. A priest of the Diocese of Leeds for 40 years, Bishop-Elect Moger has, until now, been the Rector of the National Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham in Norfolk.
