A MASS FOR YOUR INTENTIONS The Mass is the highest prayer we can offer since it is the prayer of Christ Himself. If you would like to have a Mass offered for your intentions (e.g., in thanksgiving, to celebrate an anniversary, for someone who is sick, for someone who has

died, or any need), please write your intention on an envelope, put the stipend inside (this is your offering to the priest) and either put it in the collection, or hand it to Fr Larkin. If you would like the Mass on a particular day, we will try our best to accommodate it.
