ANNUAL LEEDS DIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE TO WALSINGHAM The Annual Leeds Diocesan Pilgrimage to Walsingham will take place this year on Saturday 28 September 2024. As I will be in Rome for the Synod again this year on that date, the Pilgrimage will be led by the Dean of the Cathedral, Very Rev Canon Matthew Habron. It will begin with the Angelus and the celebration of Holy Mass at 12:00 Noon at the Shrine located near the Slipper Chapel. The Mass will be followed by a break for Lunch. At 2:30pm there will be a Solemn Procession into the village of Walsingham, concluding with Vespers and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament in the grounds of the Ancient Shrine around 3:30pm.

FOOD BANK The Good Shepherd community has a long record of helping those in need. Many parishioners regularly support local food banks. We are indebted to Barry Geldard who has on our behalf and for many years taken offerings left in the church entrance to the distribution centres. Warmer weather may bring some relief to hard pressed families and individuals in the form of lower utility bills but, the need for food and simple hygiene products does not diminish.
