THE GOOD SHEPHERD LUNCHEON CLUB I wish to inform all our guests that, regrettably, the reopening of the Luncheon Club scheduled for **Wednesday 7 January 2026** will need to be **delayed**. This is due to one of the industrial boilers that heats the lounge area requiring full replacement. The heating engineer inspected the system prior to our Christmas lunch and advised that the boiler has reached the end of its working life and should be replaced as a matter of prudence. I am currently awaiting confirmation from the engineer regarding the **installation date and final cost**. These boilers are of an industrial grade and, once fitted, are expected to serve reliably for **approximately 10–12 years**, offering warmth and comfort well into the years ahead. I am most grateful for your patience and understanding, and look forward to welcoming you back as soon as the work is completed and the lounge is once again properly warmed.

JUSTICE AND PEACE. Our Justice and Peace group has been trying for some time to make our world, and our small part of it, a bit more just and peaceful. The shortage of affordable housing is an example of injustice. This is being addressed by Calder Valley Community Land Trust, founded in 2014 and serving Mytholmroyd, Hebden Bridge and Todmorden. So far, the Trust has, among other things, built 6 independent living bungalows for older people in Walsden, occupied since 2020, looked after Fielden Hall in Todmorden, has acquired a house in Hebden Bridge and has even been donated a semi-detached house in Todmorden.

The Trust has successfully bought two homes attached to Fielden Hall by raising investment from the community and supported this by also raising grant funding and is looking to repeat this success.

At present, funds are being raised to purchase a dwelling in Heptonstall which would have become another AirBnB without this campaign fails. So far, £165,000 has been raised, including over £40,000 in community share investments from local people, towards a target of around £250,000. This money would enable the Trust to buy the house, at a generous discount, and spend over £60,000 to improve it. If successful, this will be the second local dwelling to be bought by the Trust, refurbished and let to people in desperate housing need. The first, in Brunswick Street, Hebden Bridge now houses a woman and her child who had been sleeping on a settee in her parents' house. Local people should be able to live locally in a secure, warm, affordable home and the Trust, with help, is achieving this.
